Using a mix of scientific investigation and hands-on knowhow, Slack relies on his advanced training, years of construction experience and an array of top-of-the-line equipment such as moisture meters (protimeters) and advanced fiber optic scopes (borescopes), during each thorough inspection to detect hidden mold and moisture intrusion. Slack also uses thermal imaging technology (FLIR) for infrared inspections to find hidden problem that would be otherwise inaccessible to the human eye.

The tech, used by military, aerospace and medical applications, can detect moisture sources of mold, such as pipe and duct work leaks, roof and ceiling leaks and foundation cracks, along with heat and energy loss, structural concerns, missing insulation and ventilation problems.

Another key component of ensuring a home is free from harmful mold comes in the form of air monitoring. Air samples are collected via Alergenco-D cassette. This type of sampler imparts spores in an Alergenco-D cassette at a rate of 15 cubic liters for five minutes. After the sampling period, the impacted cassettes are sent to an AIHA-certified laboratory for visual identification under the microscope. The laboratory reports the species and airborne spore quantities which can be helpful in determining potential health risks and to help develop an appropriate plan for professional mold remediation when necessary.

Finally, when the results are in and studied, Slack and his team help homeowners come up with a detailed remediation plan, which would then be sent to a qualified third-party specialist so there is no conflict of interest or questions about the veracity of the report.

Mold Pro also offers post-remediation visits to col-

lect clearance samples and verify the work was done right, and they will happily recommend high-quality dehumidification systems and HEPA air purification systems to maintain a safe and healthy home.

Inspection and testing are Mold Pros' only business, but they examine much more than buildings and structures. Other services include mold inspections for cars, trucks and RVs, as well as yachts and boats, where mildew can be a big problem, especially below deck.
